7206	<p>THE FEES 2019-2020</p> <p>Prior to the meeting the Clerk had circulated a Fees report 2019-2020 for consideration. This outlined the fees for the cemetery, allotments, tennis courts and football pitches for the forthcoming financial year. Cllr R Ellison considered that the fees had been increased the previous year but that this year there should be no further increase as the income received was sufficient for service delivery. Cllr A Sharpe asked if users of the tennis court facilities were satisfied with current arrangements and key collections and Cllr R Ellison replied that feedback had been good.</p>		
7207	<p>SUNNINGHILL VICTORIAN STREET FAYRE (SUNDAY 18 NOVEMBER 2018)</p> <p>Cllr B Hilton outlined final arrangements to be made and said that everything was progressing extremely well. Separate action notes were taken and circulated immediately to Councillors.</p>		
7208	<p>OUTDOOR FILM SCREENING AT VICTORY FIELD</p> <p>At the previous Full Council meeting Councillors heard that the Cordes Hall outdoor summer film screening, held at the field adjacent to St Michael and All Angels Church in Sunninghill, had been a great success. Some Councillors had previously felt that the Victory Field might be a good venue for the event. Feedback from the recent Cordes Hall Management Committee had indicated that the Film Club were satisfied with the venue they had used and were planning to hold their next event in the same location. The Clerk stated that she had suggested to the Film Club that they approach the Parish Council should they wish to discuss the future use of Victory Field.</p> <p>Action 4: Clerk to inform the Parish Councillors should she receive an approach from the Cordes Hall Film Club.</p>	Clerk	19/11/18
7209	<p>PARTY IN THE PARK 2019</p> <p>It was agreed to start organising the Party in the Park 2019 immediately after Christmas and Councillors were open to new ideas for the event.</p> <p>The Clerk informed Councillors that the keys for the new pavilion in Victory Field were given to her the previous week as the contractors had now completed the project. The Clerk and project manager were preparing an instruction manual for users of the pavilion. It was agreed that the pavilion would be formally opened in half-term February 2019 (when charity cheques from the Sunninghill Victorian Street Fayre would be presented) and that a dedication of Victory Field would take place at the Summer Party as it was the 100th anniversary of the year in which the field was obtained for use as a public open space</p>		
7210	<p>ANY OTHER BUSINESS</p> <p>Benches in Sunninghill High Street: Councillors had observed that there were very few benches along the Sunninghill High Street and people sat on walls and ledges which were not user-friendly, especially for the elderly.
