**Minutes of a meeting of Sunninghill & Ascot Parish Council**

**7851 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE**

Apologies were received from Cllr C Herring. Councillors J Gripton and S Jones were absent.

**7852 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST**

The Chairman asked to receive any Declarations of Interest in accordance with the adopted Code of Conduct. None were received.

**7853 ANPR**

The Council considered the proposal to provide funding to Thames Valley Police for an Automatic Number Plate Recognition (ANPR) camera to be sited in the parish. The issue has been raised in Neighbourhood Action Group meetings and Sunningdale Parish Council was also approached and has agreed to provide funding for a camera in their parish. A detailed outline of the reasons for the request and the sums involved was provided by the clerk. Discussion took place following which a vote was taken.

The council resolved to provide £3,000 funding for an ANPR camera by a majority of 12 to 1, with 1 councillor abstaining.

**7854 OPERATION BRIDGES**

The Clerk advised the meeting that all parishes have been advised to prepare their own Protocol for Marking the Death of a Senior Figure, taking information that has been fed down from government setting out the appropriate actions and timings.

The protocol sets out the parish council's response to, in particular, the death of a senior member of the royal family and covers statements to be made, the appearance of the website, the raising and lowering of flags and the wearing of black arm bands/rosettes, as well as books of condolence and the laying of flowers. The clerk has liaised with the Racecourse who also have a protocol drawn up for these circumstances.

The clerk and assistant clerk, in co-operation with the chairman, have been working on putting this together for our parish and it is nearly completed. When completed it will be made available for all councillors to view on the website.

There being no further business the meeting closed at 21.10.
