

Minutes of NAG meeting Monday 7th October.

Crime Summary by Michelle since the 19th August meeting as follows:

Burglaries Dwellings. 5. Three in Ascot, and 2 in Sunninghill.

Burglaries Business. 2 in Ascot.

Burglaries Sheds. 1 in Ascot.

Theft of Motor Vehicles. 5. Three in Ascot, and 2 in Sunninghill.

Theft from Motor Vehicles. 2. One in Ascot and 1 in Sunninghill.

Vehicle Nuisance. Not really discussed, as not currently a police priority. (Parking responsibility is the Boroughs, who have outsourced this activity to a private company)

A.S.B. Little to report, although John and his wife have recently received abuse from local youths at their Broomhill park home. . The police are aware of this. Also, there has been a problem with children of travellers having a party at the Stag pub, and the police have taken action on this. There has been a tent on the pavement opposite the racecourse, but the occupant is known, and not really causing any problems. If rehoming was required, this would be the responsibility of the R.B.W.M.

Neighbourhood Watch Updates. Valerie stated that there has been 2 new watches set up in Sunninghill, and also that they are visiting and assisting local lonely residents. Valerie also mentioned that the manager of Waitrose Sunningdale is concerned about thefts and threats. Michelle stated that the police are aware of this and the local P.C.S.O. regularly attends the store. Valerie also mentioned that there has been very little response from youths re the recent survey.

A.O.B. Michelle mentioned that there is currently plans to possibly change the current police areas, and possibly incorporate Bracknell and Slough with Ascot. Also officers are having to reapply for their jobs, although hopefully Michelle will stay with Ascot.

Matt stated he had been in contact with R.B.W.M. re removing the burnt out caravan in the layby by the Royal Berkshire hotel, but they have said this is the responsibility of the police. Michelle will look into this.

Jacqui has suggested that our meeting on the 16th December can be held at the Racecourse, so we all look forward to expensive presents this Christmas!

Helen mentioned that unfortunately David's operation has been delayed, so I will be happy to chair the meetings until he returns. We all send him our very best wishes.
